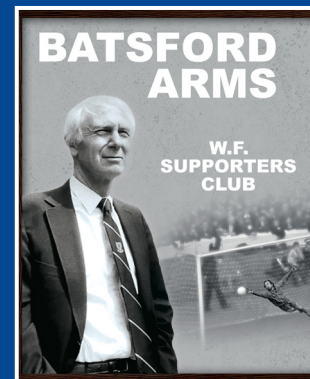
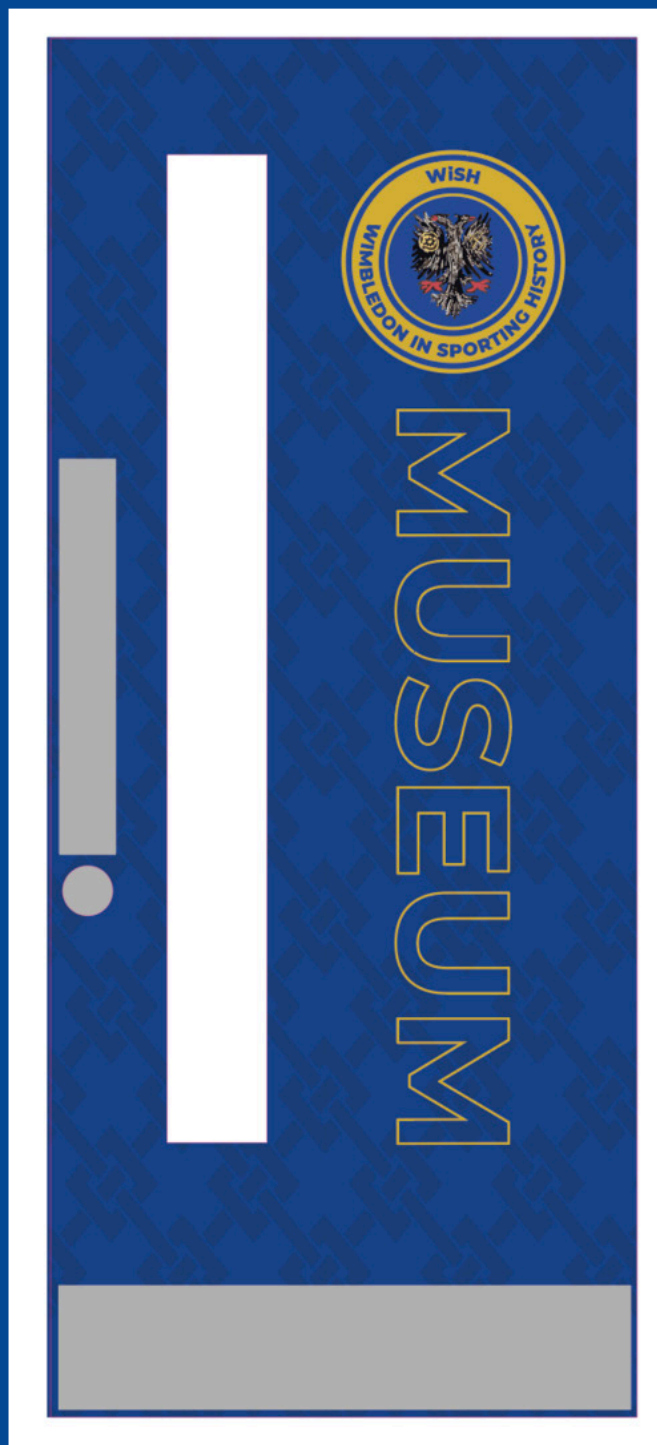


# WISH
