Volunteer hour role is estimated at 4 hours a week.

- Be friendly, cheerful and make visitors feel welcome.
- Enjoy engaging with a diverse range of people.
- Work well with the Stadium Tour Team Lead and Stadium Tour Guide team.
- Ensure safety, e.g. potential overcrowding.
- Answer simple queries.
- Monitor security.
- Liaise with shop management.
- Ensure that TV's in TGS Museum are utilised and support Stadium Tour Guide Team Lead with content ideas.
- Encourage visitors to provide feedback in the feedback books in the Museum.
- Complete all required volunteer paperwork.
- Become part of a friendly, supportive team
